Complete Option A or Option B.

NOTE: Although requirements 1 & 2 and the introduction to requirement 3 in Option A differ from requirement 1 and the introduction to requirement 2 in Option B, the balance of the requirements in both options (3a-5 in Option A and 2a-4 in Option B) are identical.

- c 1. With the help of your den leader or family, plan and participate in a campout.
- c 2. On arrival at the campout, with your den and den leader or family, determine where to set up your tent.
- c Demonstrate knowledge of what makes a good tent site and what makes a bad one.

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- c **Set up your tent without help from an adult.**
- c **3. Once your tents are set up, discuss with your den and den leader or family what actions you should take in the case of the following extreme weather events (Continue below)**

Option B:

- c **1. With the help of your den leader or family, plan and participate in an outdoor activity.**
- c **2. Discuss with your den or family what actions you should take in the case of the following extreme weather events:**

Option A-3 and Option B-2 both continue here:

- c **a. Severe rainstorm causing flooding**

- c **b. Severe thunderstorm with lightning or tornadoes**

- c **c. Fire, earthquake, or other disaster that will require evacuation.**

- c **Discuss what you have done to minimize as much danger as possible.**

- c **A-4 / B-3. Show how to tie a bowline.**

- c **Explain when this knot should be used and why.**

- c **Teach it to another Scout who is not a Webelos Scout..**

- c **A-5 / B-4. Recite the Outdoor Code and the Leave No Trace Principles for Kids from memory.**
